

Year 6 Book Selection

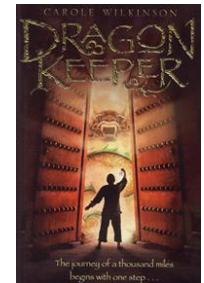
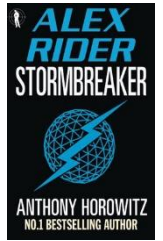
As well as being an enjoyable pastime, reading impacts hugely on children's writing ability and general learning. We encourage children to read as much as possible, both at home and in school.

To assist with the difficult task of choosing a new book, we have put together a reading list which features a selection of books. We encourage children to read something that they may not normally have chosen.

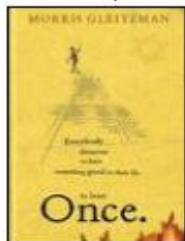
Books underlined are class readers and will be studied in English and guided reading lessons.

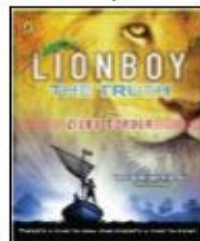
