Make up prices for the things that you sell and ask your family to visit.</p> <p>Can you work out the total of the things they buy?</p> <p>Make sure that you have asked permission before you do this!</p>
<p>Can you measure the height of all the members of your family in metres and centimetres? Make a table to show the results.</p> <p>You could also measure other things like foot length, arm length, head circumference.</p>	<p>How many different exercises or activities can you do in 1 minute?</p> <p>Ask someone to time you doing exercises like skipping or star jumps.</p>	<p>Can you find out the temperature outside each day for a week?
