Key Vocabulary	
Winter	Winter is the coldest season of the year. It comes after Autumn and before Spring.
Snow	Clusters of ice crystals that fall from the clouds.
Ice	Ice is frozen water.
Frost	Small white crystals formed on the ground or other surfaces when it gets very cold outside..

Playdough recipe

- 2 cups of plain flour
- 1 cup of salt
- 2 tablespoons of cooking oil
- 4 teaspoons of cream of tartar
- 2 cups of cold water

Place all the ingredients in a pot and cook over a low heat, stirring constantly. When the mixture forms into a dough like consistency and is difficult to stir, empty it onto a floured work top and knead if necessary. Once cooled, your play dough is ready to use.
