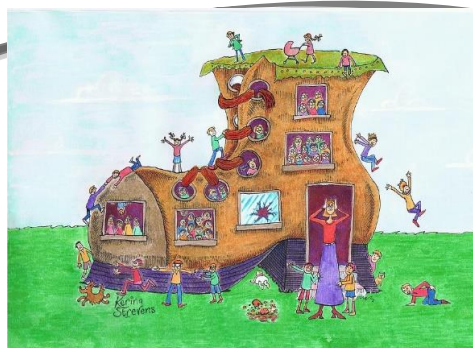
Learn new language
