## Explore

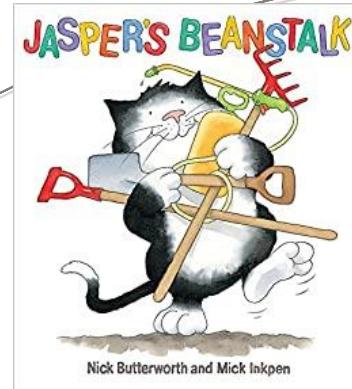
Please use the information below to support your child's learning at home 😊

We look at the front of the book and the pictures first.

**What** is the title of the book?

**Who** do you think the main character in the book is?

**Where** is the story set and what shows us what sort of place it is?



## Read

We read the story using the pictures to support the written word. This helps us to understand the meaning of new and unfamiliar words.

## Adventures

What is your favourite vegetable? Ask your family members too.

How many different vegetables can you name?

Plant a runner bean and keep it growing.

Measure your beanstalk with bricks, spoons, lolly sticks....

Explore the texture of shaving foam clouds. Put shaving foam in a shallow baking tray or on a table (suitably protected if it is made of wood).

How many beans did Jasper plant?

What did Jasper do on Wednesday?

What did Jasper use to find the slugs and snails?

What was Jasper waiting for on Sunday?

Why was Jasper sad and grumpy on Monday?

How did Jasper look after his bean?
