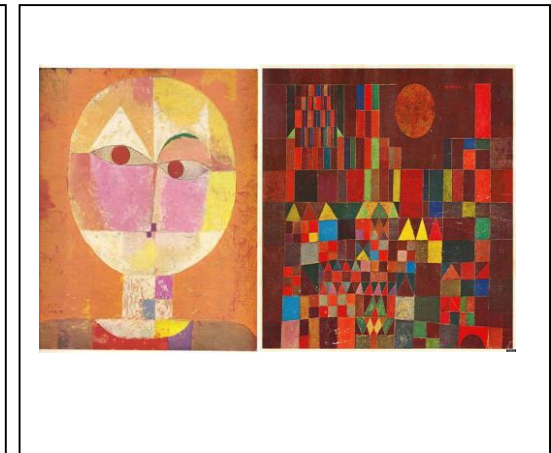
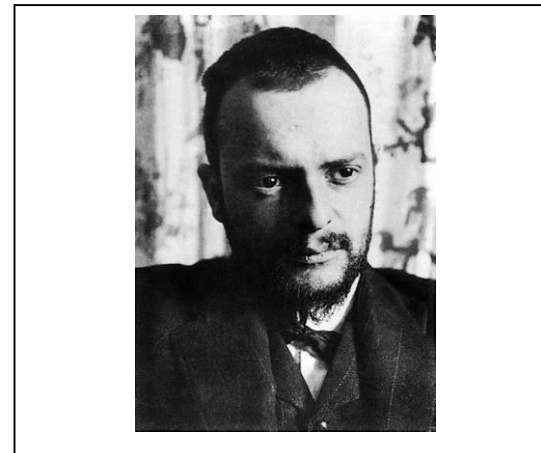


This term, we are learning...

Vocabulary	Definition
Primary	They are called primary colours because they cannot be created by mixing any other colours. Red, yellow and blue.
Secondary	A secondary colour is as a result of mixing two primary colours. These are green, purple or orange.
Lighter	A paler or whiter shade.
Darker	A colour with more black added.
Colour	What is produced when light strikes an object and is reflected to the eye.
Texture	The look and feel of a piece of art.
Portrait	A painting or drawing of a person or people.
Self-portrait	A painting or drawing that the artist creates of themselves.

He was most famous for painting, drawing and using watercolour.

He experimented with the colour theory.
