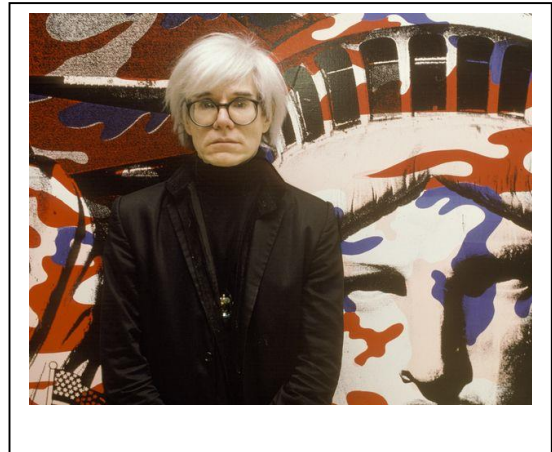


This is our 'Create' term, when we learn about art and artists.

Vocabulary	Definition
Structure	The arrangement or placement of the different elements.
Foreground	The area that appears closest to the view on a painting.
Middle ground	The area between the foreground and background on a painting.
Background	The area that appears furthest from the viewer on a painting.
Prototype	An early example model built to test out an idea
Statement	An artist's written description of their work to help the viewer understand.
Create	To make something special.
Mood board	A type of collage using images, text, samples and colours made to share an idea or feeling about a topic.

Our Focus Artist is Andy Warhol



Key Knowledge -

- Andy Warhol an American artist who was born in 1928 and died in 1987
- He was famous for his silk screen printing technique that allowed him to create many images of the same object, but with slight differences - usually with colour
- He started his career drawing for advertisements and he continued to use everyday objects in his art
- His artistic style is called Pop Art, as artists in this style use popular subjects in their images.
