All existing Seesaw accounts can continue to be used, and have simply been transferred to their new year groups on the system.

*Please help us by checking the following:*

*Ensure that **your child's name** is entered on the account, and **not a parent or carer's name**. It is important for teachers to be able to easily identify all pupils. This can be rectified in 'settings' when logging in to Seesaw. Do not hesitate to contact us at school if you require support in checking and adjusting this.*

If you are new to the school and do not yet have access to Seesaw, we will send you information in order to help you to register easily at home.
